# 3 PINEBURR AVE PROPERTY REAL ESTATE LISTING AGREEMENT

The council is requested to consider amending the listing price.

## 4 POOL COVER OPTIONS

The cost of the aluminum frame pool cover system is now estimated to be \$1.3 million, which exceeds the prior estimate by \$800,000. Council expects to consider the revised estimate after being updated on the status of a \$500,000 grant, which may be reported as early as August 23. If the grant application is not approved, council may consider alternative solutions.

### 5 STREET RESURFACING

The Town Council is awaiting final contractor bids that the NC Department of Transportation, District 13 Engineer is obtaining for the 32 streets that the Street Planning Committee and Staff have recommended to the Council. Prior information provided to the Council and posted on the Town website along with the Aug 5 agenda included the DOT District 13 Engineer's cost estimates.

Whenever the Council has the bids, it will consider approval of the work ASAP, so the work can begin.

Until the bids are received, the Council intends to take no action.
